

City of LaBelle Community Development Block Grant Sewer and Water Line Improvement Project

Early Notice for Public Review

of a Proposal to Support Activity in the 100-Year Floodplain and Wetland

The City of LaBelle has submitted an application for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG funds) to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO). The funding is provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and will be used to complete a sewer and water line improvement project that will include 2400 LF of sewer main lines, sewer hookups, 2400 LF of 6 inch water main line, replacement of and installation of new fire hydrants in order to benefit a low to moderate income neighborhood with improvement to facilities that will protect public health and

the environment with CDBG funds, grant number 18DB-OM-09-36-02-N31. This notice is required by Section 2(a)(4) of Executive Order 11988 for Floodplain Management, and by Section 2(b) of Executive Order 11990 for the Protection of Wetlands, and is implemented by HUD Regulations found at 24 CFR 55.20(b) for the HUD action that is within and/or affects a floodplain or wetland. Construction will be undertaken in the 100-year floodplain or near wetlands. The City of LaBelle is interested in alternatives and public perceptions of possible adverse im-

pacts that could result from the project as well as potential mitigation measures. The installation 2400 LF of new sewer lines and sewer hook ups, installation of 2400 LF of new water lines, the replacement and or installation of new fire hydrants service areas are located within the floodplain area. These sewer improvements will take place on Citrus Street and Pamona Circle, water line improvements will take place on East Lincoln Ave., Fire Hydrant replacement and/or installation will take place on Martin Luther King and Cowboy Way and also at Pinewood Street and Cowboy Way in the City of LaBelle, Hendry County,

Florida. These projects will take place within the improved right-of-way. The project will serve low to moderate income residents by eliminating on-site septic systems that do not meet modern requirements and having a tendency to perform below standards, water line replacement will provide modern PVC mains of sufficient size for fire flow and peak water demand hours including a loop for redundancy and public safety to serve fire hydrants updated to modern code serving residents with proper coverage. Hendry County proposes to adopt the following by ordinance:

Ordinance Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HENDRY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE HENDRY COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 1-53, ZONING, SPECIFICALLY, SECTION 1-53-6.13, AIRPORTS; SECTION 1-53-3, ZONING DISTRICTS; AND SECTION 1-53-4, DIMENSIONAL AND DENSITY REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS OF LAW; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, INCLUSION IN CODE, AND SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

All interested parties are invited to appear and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance. Oral and written comments will be accepted. 

Maps depicting the affected areas around LaBelle Airport and Airglades Airport are adjacent to this advertisement.
